We strive to continually improve your experience at Disneyland Paris to make your visit even more magical. The entrance to Walt Disney Studios Park will be redesigned and various areas of the park will be closed during several phases of work. Ask a Cast Member for more information.

### KEY TO SYMBOLS

- Dedicated ticket counter for disabled guests at the entrance of the parks. Accessibility information point (Access Cards)
- First aid. Changing facilities for an adult or child (over 3 years of age) Cold storage for medication
- Automated External Defibrillator
- Smoking area. Special areas have been set aside for those who wish to smoke. Please smoke only in these designated areas
- Toilets accessible for guests with disabilities
- Baby Care Center Lost Children
- Stroller and wheelchair hire
- Shop
- Restaurant
- Shop or restaurant with magnetic loop
- Guest Storage (additional charge)

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Priority Card:** To receive a Priority Card, anyone who is officially registered as disabled must present proof of disability to one of our information desks. This card grants priority (but non-immediate) access to our attractions, shows, shops and restaurants. The list of official documents proving disability accepted by Disneyland Paris is available on [Disneylandparis.com](https://www.disneylandparis.com)
- To receive a bracelet giving priority access to our shops and restaurants, expectant mothers can go to any of our information desks and present a proof of pregnancy.
- Guide and assistance dogs are welcome at Disneyland Paris including in our shops and restaurants. Please use the green spaces for them to do their business and clean up after them.
- Book your restaurant via the Disneyland Paris app or by calling one of our advisers on +33 (0)1 60 30 40 50.
- Magnetic induction loops are installed at reception desks and in our restaurants and stores' cash
- Shopping Service: From €50 spent in Disneyland® Paris shops and before 3pm, leave your purchases with us. You can then pick them up at your Disney Hotel shop or at Disney Village® (ask in any Disney shop for details).
- The Disney Parks are non-smoking environments. This policy also applies to electronic cigarettes and vaping. Smoking is permitted where you see the symbol. Please smoke only in these designated areas.
- Our parks and some of our restaurants are equipped with Virtuoz. A tablet with audio and tactile maps that enables visually impaired and blind people to understand and move around their environment. Free service, available on request from Studio Services.
- Our attractions and restaurants offer Audio-Description information, including menus, thanks to the free AudioSpot app. The Audio-Description service will start automatically when you approach.
